The recessed LED fixture is for remodels or new construction. Choose size/color temperature, beam angle and trim shape/finish and you’re good to go.

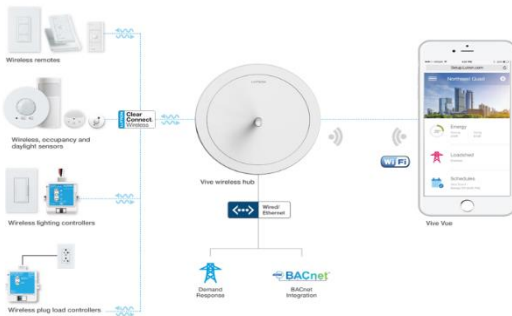
Best Lamp: Universal Lighting Technologies Inc., Everline LED Sign Tube.

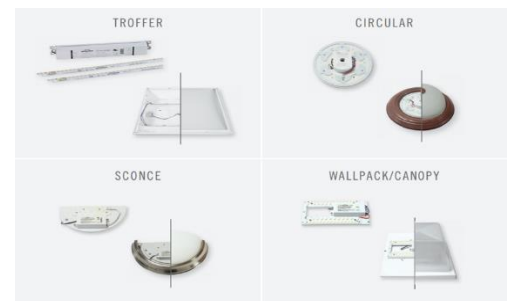
